"New England's Youngest Farm"

was how Dutch Hollow was introduced in a story published in the September 5, 1976 Jersey Journal. The herd had 70 milkers, most from Fair Weather Farms but 11 from Natalie Snare's Kamefield Farm, plus 30 young stock—all being bred artificially to plus proven bulls with an eye to the polled factor. Each family member was the owner of their own cattle. "The whole family takes an active part in the farm operation [and] look forward to developing a herd of high producing, good typed Jerseys, and remaining active with what they consider the greatest group of people anywhere."

Three generations now own and breed Jerseys of their own at Dutch Hollow, which is nine times the size it was 36 years ago. The cows have never been more productive, or better in type. Every day, we carry on the legacy of a Master Breeder, our father, grandfather and great-grandfather Stanley N. Chittenden. When it was far from fashionable, he bred and promoted Jersey cattle for commercial dairies. He also saw the benefit of developing the polled gene for the benefit of his herd and the advantage of the Jersey breed.

Jerseys are our livelihood, our passion, and our future. We are indebted to "the greatest group of people anywhere" who have inspired, guided and encouraged each generation. Thank you, and thank you to the Board of Directors for honoring Dutch Hollow Farm as Master Breeders of the American Jersey Cattle Association.
